# QST DE DON KOIJANE PERHAM FOUNDATION

## ELECTRONICS MUSEUM v. FOOTHILL COLLEGE

The suit by the Perham Foundation against the Foothill-DeAnza Community College District, regarding the disposition of the Electronics Museum, is in the final settlement phase.

Judge Jeremy Fogel of the Superior Court, County of Santa Clara, residing in Palo Alto has discussed several alternate solutions. One solution would be for the Perham Foundation to move the museum and the collection to a new, off campus location in exchange for a yet to be negotiated dollar amount. This alternative solution may be resolved when the college board meets to consider the option on Jan. 7th.

Final settlement is expected to be concluded during the first quarter of 1991. If a settlement is reached and the museum must move, much help will be needed to find space to safely store the collection and to find a new location for the Electronics Museum. In addition, donations and volunteers are needed to work with the museum staff on a continuing basis.

Note that the Perham Foundation is the sponsoring organization for all of the Amateur Radio Electronics Flea Markets held at Foothill College every year. 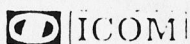

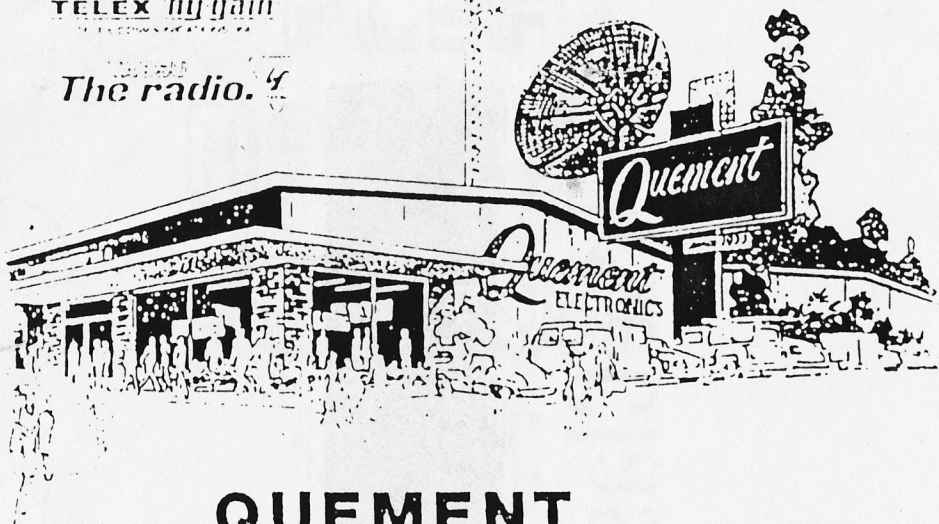
