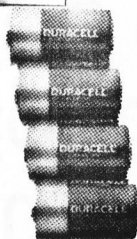

Curing Battery Saver & Subaudible Tone Delay

Since the 523 repeater has implemented sub-audible tone squelch (PL), many stations have been heard saying "monitoring". More specifically, these stations have been *barely* heard. What typically comes through clearly is the word *monitoring* and sometimes part of the station's call. This effect has also been noticed on other PL repeaters.

This is due to two factors. One, the repeater takes several milliseconds to detect the PL before turning on the repeater transmitter. Secondly, most modern HTs are physically smaller which has been accomplished, in part, by smaller battery packs. To enable a smaller battery pack to last an acceptable length of time, these HTs use battery savers. These savers turn on the HT receiver for only a few milliseconds out of every second which reduces the average battery current drain. If a signal is present, the receiver is left on, otherwise, it is turned off again.

When someone keys their microphone, and immediately says "W6ABC Monitoring", the combination of the small delay time in the repeater PL detector and the receiver battery saver act to cut off part or all of the station's call. If your receiver is also using PL decode, add an additional delay time for that circuit to function. The

variability depends upon when the transmitting station comes on the air compared to the "wake-up-cycle" of the HT battery saver. If the battery saver has just turned on the receiver, the word loss will be minimal. If the battery saver has just turned off the receiver, the amount of the transmission lost will be maximized.

The cure is simply stated, but, from personal experience, not always easy to remember. When making a call on a repeater, push to talk, then wait a second, then state your call slowly and clearly. You will be more likely to receive a response.

two brothers, Donald of Millbrae and Philip of Milpitas.

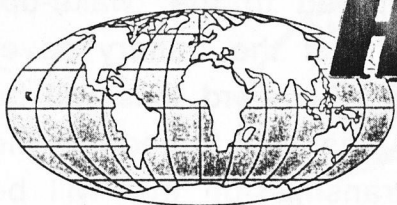
