



"WORK A CRUISE SHIP HAM--WIN AN AWARD" **CONTINUES!**

In the November issue of PAARAgraphs, we presented Part I of this article. For those of you who may have missed this first segment, I will summarize its contents simply by saying that it dealt with the particular set-up and operating schedule of the First Radio Officer of the "Royal Viking Sea" cruise ship and the interesting fact that if one works this officer, one will receive an award (in addition to the amazing QSO's). And now the conclusion:

Now for the particulars of the award. I will quote directly from Mikalsen's letter: "As for my award, 'Worked LA3FL/MM' requires a minimum RST of 539. No more than 2 bands can be worked within the same day (GMT). All 4 contacts must be worked from the same QTH ashore and under one call. Upon completing 4 band QSO's, I will send the certificate and a Cruise Atlas when I receive 4 QSL cards; one for each band."

Mikalsen also says that he is QRV mostly around 9 A.M. and 9 P.M. ship's time. However, it is difficult to compute GMT time as the ship's local time keeps changing as it sails along. That is also one

reason why he cannot set up any specific skeds.

According to the steamship company, the "Royal Viking Sea" will be in the Los Angeles-San Francisco area October 16 to 18 [Sorry, we missed him-ed.], on December 19 through 21, 1986, and again on March 16 through 18, 1987.




