ED. FAIREANKS

(ED FAIRBANKS WEAIN QSL CARD, 1940's VINTAGE--SEE DATE LINE, -ED)

ED FAIRBANKS REMEMBERED -

MEMBERS OF PAARA - ESPECIALLY THE LONG TIMERS - RECALL ED FAIRBANKS WEAIN FOR HIS QUIET DEVOTION TO THE CLUB. MOST OF US REMEMBER ED AS PURVEYOR OF COFFEE, REFRESHMENTS, & RAFFLE TICKETS AT MEETINGS, AND AS CUSTODIAN OF CLUB PROPERTY (I.E. THE TRAILER & ALL THE GEAR STORED IN AND AROUND IT IN THE SRI PARKING LOT). HOWEVER, FOR MANY YEARS ED WAS A FIELD DAY SPARKPLUG, HIS SPECIALTY WAS PLANNING & INSTALLING ANTENNAS AT WHATEVER SITE THE CLUB COULD WANGLE. USUALLY DURING A FIELD DAY OVERNIGHT, ED COULD BE FOUND ROAMING THE SETUP MAKING SURE THE TROOPS WERE FED & KEPT COFFEED UP.

ED WAS ONE OF THE EARLY MENLO PARK RACES ORGANIZERS; HE, BOB BAUM, & STEVE STUNTZ HELD SEVERAL INITIAL MEETINGS WITH THE CITY MANAGER TO INTRODUCE HAM RADIO INTO THE CITY'S EMERGENCY PLANNING. BEYOND THAT, HE PARTICIPATED IN COUNTLESS SIMULATED EMERGENCY TESTS AND PUBLIC SERVICE EVENTS OVER THE YEARS, USUALLY TAKING THE MOST DISTANT OR OUT OF THE WAY LOCATION ASSIGNMENTS.

PROBABLY THE MOST ENDURING AND DEMANDING OF ED'S COMMITMENTS TO PAARA, HOWEVER, WAS TO THE PUBLICA-TION OF PAARAGRAPHS. IN THE LONG PERIOD WHEN THE MONTHLY JOURNAL WAS PRINTED ON THE CLUB'S ANCIENT MIMEOGRAPH MACHINE, ED WAS ALWAYS ON HAND TO KEEP THE MACHINE RUNNING, OVERSEE THE FOLDING & STAPLING OF THE COPIES, AND MAKE SURE THEY WERE PROPER-LY STAMPED, PACKAGED & POSTED. NEED-LESS TO SAY, ED ALWAYS TOOK ON THESE MENIAL-SEEMING CHORES IN GOOD HUMOR AND WITH A PURPOSEFUL QUIET THAT APPEAR-ED SELF-EFFACING, NOBODY EVER SAW ED LOSE HIS COOL; HE ALWAYS HAD A CLEAR HEADED SOLUTION FOR THE MOST VEXING PROBLEMS OF KEEPING PAARA GLUED TO-GETHER. IN BELATED RECOGNITION OF ED'S INVALUABLE SUPPORT OF THE CLUB. HE WAS AWARDED IN AUGUST THE VERY FIRST HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP EVER CONFERRED. ONLY A COUPLE OF WEEKS LATER, ED WAS A SILENT KEY, APPRECIA-TION CAME LATE BUT WEAIN WILL BE LONG REMEMBERED BY THOSE WHO HAD THE PRIVILEGE OF HIS ACQUAINTANCE. AT THE TIME OF HIS PASSING, ED WAS 82 AND HAD BEEN A HAM FOR ABOUT 60 YEARS.


