

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

In response to the influx of new radio amateurs (many of whom are interested in upgrading) the Palo Alto 523 repeater has recently changed the autodial test number from the U.S. Geological Survey to the Sunnyvale VEC recording. This recording explains when and where the next test sessions will be held in Northern California. For additional VEC information, the ARRL VEC recording has also been added to the list of numbers available. If you already have the existing lists, add the number 22 for the ARRL VEC.

Hams who would like a copy of the full emergency autodial list should send:

- A self-addressed-stamped-envelope (SASE) plus
- A photocopy of their amateur radio license

to (note the new address):

523 Repeater, P.O. Box 391288, Mountain View, Ca, 94039-391288

The Palo Alto 145.230 repeater has offered free Emergency access autodial codes to any licensed amateur for many years. These numbers permit any ham with a two-meter radio to dial up the police, fire, or paramedics in any community on either side of the bay from San Francisco and Berkeley to the North to San Jose in the South. The California Highway Patrol, AAA Road Service, local Sheriffs' offices, and Allstate Road Service are also available. In addition, the security services on eight local college campuses as well as local park rangers are reachable via these emergency numbers. To date, in excess of 450 copies of these numbers have been distributed to area hams. The addition of the VEC numbers is the latest expansion of our service to the Amateur Radio community.

The Emergency Autodial lists are available at no charge as a service of SARS and SPARK, the two radio clubs that operate the Palo Alto 523 Repeater. SARS is the SRI Amateur Radio Society (the ham club of SRI International), and SPARK is the South Peninsula Amateur Radio Klub (the ham club of the Loral Aerospace companies).

PERIPHERAL VISION PRODUCT REVIEW

IN A PREVIOUS PRODUCT REVIEW WE MADE NOTE IN GENERAL TERMS OF THE INFLUENCE OF COMPUTERS IN THE AMATEUR RADIO COMMUNICATIONS ENVIRONMENT. THE SYMBIOTIC AND SYNERGISTIC RELATIONSHIP OF THE MICROCOMPUTER AND RADIO COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT IS A FACT OF TECHNOLOGICAL LIFE THAT IS A BOON TO HAMS, ESPECIALLY IF THEY BE DEDICATED TO MATTERS OF EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE.

ILLUSTRATION:

THE COMMUNICATIONS ENVIRONMENT OF AMATEUR RADIO IS ENHANCED GREATLY TODAY BY THE PRESENCE OF PACKET RADIO SYSTEMS THAT PARALLEL THE DIGITAL INFORMATION TRANSMISSION SYSTEMS OF COMMERCIAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS. THE 1989 CALIFORNIA EARTHQUAKE BROUGHT THIS HOME IN A GREAT WAY. THE ABILITY OF THE PACKET NETWORK TO MANAGE WHAT IT DID WAS A TRIBUTE TO HAMS' INGENUITY AND THE UTILIZATION OF EVER MORE ENHANCED EQUIPMENT PLATFORMS IN A CONTEXT OF PUBLIC SERVICE. THE LATTER IS THE FACTOR OF GREAT IMPOPTANCE: THE ABILITY TO BE OF SERVICE TO THE PUBLIC IS DIRECTLY PROPORTIONAL TO THE QUALITY OF THE EQUIPMENT BROUGHT TO BEAR FOR THE PURPOSE.

ITEM:

PC PERIPHERAL FACTORS VITAL TO SUCCESS OF THE MISSION---TO ACHIEVE THE ADVANTAGES LATENT IN CPU HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE
ESPECIALLY IN A COMMUNICATION SYSTEM CONTEXT) NECESSITATES THAT SPECIAL
ATTENTION BE GIVEN TO THE VIDEO DISPLAY ENVIRONMENT--- THE CRITICAL
APPLICATIONS PARAMETERS AND SYSTEM CONFIGURATION REQUIREMENTS INCREASINGLY
DRAW UPON THE POWER OF HIGHER LEVEL VIDEO DISPLAY STANDARDS AND HARDWARE
SEVICES.

PRECOMMENDABLE IN THIS CATEGORY ARE THE PERIPHERAL DEVICES OF STB SYSTEMS WHICH ARE AVAILABLE FROM STORES IN THE BAY AREA). AS PREVIOUSLY TOUCHED UPON, THE QUALITY AND SUPPORT THAT GO WITH THE PRODUCTS OF THAT COMPANY ARE IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS IN MAKING THE CHOICE OF COMPUTER ENHANCEMENTS.

IT MAY BE SAID THAT THAT COMPANY HAS A GOOD "PERIPHERAL VISION", IN THE COMPUTER SENSE OF THE TERM! -ED.


